This will involve working with the service users, their families and other staff in developing a person-centered plan for each individual. Applicants will be required to support, service users with their personal care needs. There will be a strong emphasis on developing daily living skills that is individually based with a goal towards independence.

Applicants should hold a relevant qualification, minimum FETAC Level 5. Experience of working with people with intellectual disabilities is desirable. Excellent communication and organisational skills are required.
